NBCC has been invited to attend and volunteer at the 2019 Women's Air Race Classic. This would be for the NBCC, a 2-day event.

Women's air racing started in 1929 with the [Women's Air Derby](#). Twenty pilots raced from Santa Monica, CA to Cleveland, OH, site of the National Air Races.

The Air Race Classic was reincorporated in 2002 into the ***Air Race Classic, Inc.***, a non-profit educational organization. The "ARC" encourages and educates current and future women pilots while preserving and promoting the tradition of pioneering women in aviation.

This year's air race, the 90th anniversary, is about 2400 miles long. Starting in Jackson TN, the four day race ends in Welland ON.

Where

This all takes place at the Niagara Central Dorothy Rungeling Airport near Welland off River Road.

When and What's Required

Saturday, May 4: Airport Safety Orientation and BBQ at Niagara Central Airport, Welland

This is for all Volunteers, not just NBCC

Start 10:30 to 13:00

Friday, June 21: Fly-in Day. We are being asked to provide shuttle service for the pilots using our LBC's, from the parked airplanes to the airport hangers.

About 50 planes and around 100 pilots.

Start at 10:00 to 17:00

Note: We will setup our tent on this day, leave it overnight.

Saturday, June 22: NBCC Static Car Display at the airport, during the Air Race Classic Open House.

All setup to be completed by 8:30

Start 9:00 to 17:00

They expect about 1000 people to attend the open house.

What is Needed

1. May 4: NBCC volunteers to attend airport safety orientation.
2. Friday, June 21: NBCC volunteers to shuttle pilots using the LBC's. If possible, we can schedule drivers into teams which would overlap each other over the day. This way, unless you want to, no one has to commit to the whole day.
3. Friday, June 21: Help with setting up the static display.
4. Saturday, June 22: NBCC attendance, with the cars, for the static display.
