Observe: Ontario Historic Marker-**Chloe Cooley (blue metal)** **8.7**

RT. on Regent St. 13.7 mi.

RT. on Gage St. 14.1 mi.

RT. on King St.

Observe...on your right...

Parliament Oak School & depiction of 1793 parliament!

...on your left...

Offer... **'thinking of you' wave to Gordon's memory!**

RT. on Centre St.

RT. on Regent St.

At intersection of Regent St. & Johnson St., 14.5 mi.

Observe... site of the former NOTL Bowling Lawn, soon to become a

'Voices of Freedom Park'

LT. on Johnson St.

RT. on Simcoe St. **Caution TRAFFIC!** 14.8 mi.

LT. on Queen St.

By pass the oldest golf course in North America – 1875!

Queen St. becomes Niagara Blvd.

LT. on Wilberforce Ave. (just past the One Mile Creek!!!) 15.9 mi,

RT. around the **Circle/Chautauqua Circle**

Observe street names...**Vincent, Wycliffe, Luther, Addison...**

RT. on Addison

LT. on Shakespeare Ave. 16.2 mi.

RT. on Lakeshore Rd./Regional 87 -- Mary St. becomes Lakeshore Rd.

Observe **Butler House (green colour/on your left)** 20.3 mi.

LT. Lakeshore Antiques & Treasures-853 Lakeshore 21.0 mi.

<p>STOP 3: Lakeshore Antiques & Treasures -a 30 minute stop...military, coins, toys, ephemera ...washroom break</p>

RT. Return on Lakeshore Road

RT. Four Mile Creek 22.8 mi.

LT. Hunter Road 23.7 mi.

LT. at Stop Light onto Niagara Stone Road/Regional 55 25.3 mi.

Observe on your left – Picnic Tables – Food Trucks – Wed. Night

... possible 'Meet and Go'?

a 10 minute stop
