Tentative Niagara British Car Club Geo Cache Rules 2026:

- There will be twelve (12) numbered geo caches located throughout the region.
- Starting in February, a cache will be announced once a month (with a bonus Geo Cache at some point) and will remain in play for three weeks before being retrieved. Once geo cache is retrieved, that number is considered closed.
- Clues to these locations will be sent via e-mail, groups-io, and posted on the website. You will **not** require a GPS or smart phone. The 12 geo cache clues will NOT be posted on social media; however, a reminder of the event will be posted.
- This is a NBCC members only event. You may complete in groups if you wish.
- If you do not use a computer and wish to participate, contact Vicki Halliday or Sean Nakoneczny for other arrangements.
- Sites will not be in prohibited areas or areas where there is a parking fee or hazardous parking.
- Caches will not be hidden in any location that presents a risk of injury to club members.
- Clues will likely take you and your car only to the general vicinity. You may then have to search an area of an approximate 50 – 75 foot radius. Accessibility to the geo cache location has been considered and hopefully all members can reach them.
- Please be respectful of the search area...no uprooting, digging, damage, etc.
- When you find the cache, sign your name on the appropriate line.
- Please return the cache (container and contents, securely closed) to where you found it.
- Please **do not** share the cache location with other members who did not search with you...keeping secrets is all part of the fun.
- Club executive will be permitted to participate in their own searches since only Sean and Vicki know the locations.
- Please use your LBC in the nice weather. The underlining theme is that we want to encourage our members to join in the fun and maybe visit a new place or return to an old favourite.
- The winter Geo Cache will be a little different...please invite other members to join you in your car and make it a group activity, especially in the cold months. These hidden geo cache will be geared towards group enjoyment with a fun location at the end.
- *Other rules (if necessary) as they become evident*

No point system – just fun!!! Get out there and enjoy the ride and hopefully discover a new local gem.

**You will notice that the McInerney's name will be the first on each Geo Cache. The reason for this is that they will be "testing" each set of instructions before they are released to the club. This will reduce errors. PLEASE NOTE, they do not know the destination when testing.*
