Final destination is a local establishment operating hours 10am-5pm Monday- Saturday and 11-5 Sunday - not a sit down place but a local "retail" shop of sorts.

This is a short run, hope you enjoy

Starting site: Rotary Park – Gateway to 12-mile Creek 376 Regional Rd 69 St. Catharines

Instructions:

- Please make a left turn out of the parking lot.
- You don't need a "sign" from above, but keep Power Glen on your left.
- When traffic rules indicate you need to stop, please turn left...going down, down, down into the valley.
- If your CATARACTs are not too cloudy, you will make a right turn when appropriate.
- HINT - Don't ruin your MORNING by missing your right turn. You've gone too far if your STAR shines on the mill.
- No weapons are needed for this activity but you will pass a CLUB that supports firearms on your driver's side.
- HINT – After a stop, you may notice a giant barn on your left.
- Where all must stop, you might be tempted to head to the races. DON'T do that. Face any fears you may have and head towards ghosts and goblins and corn mazes.
- Enjoy the drive on a scenic road, continue straight for some time.
- Keep on "ROLLING" out of the "Netherlands" (if you know you know) past a popular hiking spot on your navigator's side. (not long mountains but....)
- At a stop sign you need to turn right. What stop sign you may ask! There will be a new house with a large "Overbeek" sign in the front yard.
- Almost immediately you will see a giant sign on your right that will indicate you have arrived at the "sweet" spot that makes Canada famous. Head in down the long driveway and park.
- GEO CACHE:
 - o After leaving your car, walk under the large wooden sign
 - o Go to the shop to the right of the house
 - o Once inside the shop, look high and LOW for the Geo Cache, hiding behind a large can with a geographically close state name across the front.
