

Geo Cashe #6 – Fort Erie in play July 7th- 28th

Group play is encouraged

Final destination is NOT a retailer OR establishment.

Starting site: Storage Guyz 2063 Pettit Rd Fort Erie

Instructions:

- Random place to start for a meandering drive, once you head out of the parking lot, look both ways. Towering high between the trees you will spot a “towering” indication NOT to head that way. Turn away from this sign in the sky.
- A “little” path will get you on your way
- Don’t pause but come to a full stop and look for an X to guide you straight to your destination
- Keep going friends, this is a long one
- Hint, on your right, if you look carefully, you will see where someone “stole” a number of trees lining the road
- This road confuses itself by changing names
- Your next turn means a human-made pile, stack. Or mound of stones primarily used as landmarks or trail marks....for us it is a road name. HINT: right at a stop sign with a LARGE brownish-orange house on the navigators side.
- STOP! Don’t get wet!!! Look for a Canadian “sign” to show you the way along this mess of directions
- Enjoy the view, you have some driving to do
- Along your path, as you creep along watch for fisherman
- As you watch ahead, the train bridge will be in view when you need to make the RIGHT move. HINT: A “powerful leader” would know when to turn. If EM and RICK went for a walk together, they would find themselves here.
- STOP in the name of love....before you break my heart. Left please.
- Stop lights now. Up ahead is the “north end” in red and gold through the lights keep this place on your left
- No taking “flight” on a “Sugar” high, wait for a go sign and make a safe left
- When faced with a choice, keep the obnoxious orange guy on your driver’s side. Thankfully “he’s not here” with Canadians ... which helps “keep the peace”
- Follow along for a spell, almost at your destination
- Look for a sign for Denture Clinica and Niagara Hearing Aid...no this isn’t the time to book an appointment but use this green and white sign as a clue you have almost completed this mess of instructions. Go slowly as you will park soon

- On the left, the bricks tell a story on one building...Confused yet. "Sophie's Choice is about making a decision. Sophia's place will show you that now is the time to park.

- Once parked safely, head out for a little river walk.
- Once your feet are on the "river walk" look to your left and right. Did you see a sign or two. One will enlighten you on historical facts and the other will guide you to the Cache
